SERVICE PROVIDER REPORTS

Executive Director/Administrator: In addition to the report submitted, Raymond Hughes II reflected upon his father who was instrumental in founding the Somerset County Joint Insurance Fund and noted that the Fund has been offering dividends for sixteen continuous years. He congratulated the Member Entities for their efforts to reduce claims through safety management, resulting in the available surplus. Dividend checks were distributed to member entities.

Fund Attorney/Litigation Services: No additions to report submitted.

Fund Attorney/Administrative Services: Fund Attorney Berry reported that A1347, the 21st Century First Responders Protection Act, was released from the Assembly Appropriations Committee and is now pending in the Assembly for a vote. Identical legislation, S264, has already passed the Senate in 2014 by a vote of 22-12. If passed by the Assembly, the legislation will go to the Governor for consideration.

If the legislation is signed into law it provides for, among other things, creation of a rebuttable presumption of Workers' Compensation coverage for public safety workers if exposed to known carcinogens in the course of employment. This definition of a public safety worker is similar to that which is already included in the Workers' Compensation law but not identical, and includes paid or volunteer emergency, correctional, fire, police or medical personnel. In addition, the legislation provides a rebuttable presumption for firefighters with 7 or more years of experience wherein if they suffer an illness or injury which may be caused by cancer, the cancer will be considered a compensable occupational disease.

The legislation will most likely result in increased costs due to the shift of the burden of proof from the worker to the employer in certain cases, which may result in increased claims for Workers' Compensation benefits.
