#### SERVICE PROVIDER REPORTS

Executive Director/Administrator: In addition to the report submitted, Raymond Hughes stated that the loss reports will reflect current Incurred But Not Reported (IBNR) figures as soon as they are received from the Actuary.

Further, Raymond mentioned that the Somerset County Park Foundation recently celebrated their 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary and honored Freeholder Peter Palmer for his service. All in attendance warmly added their congratulations.

Maryjane Hydro informed the Board that 2017 renewal applications will be forwarded to members shortly.

Please contact New Jersey Risk Managers immediately when there any property losses occur, such as fire, water, wind, etc. The office and staff are available 24/7 to assist with emergency remediation arrangements. Keep in mind that in such instances, the Somerset County Joint Insurance Fund does not have property deductibles that can impact budgets or cause concern.

Maryjane reminded the Commissioners that on August 2<sup>nd</sup> a training seminar for Employment Practices Liability will be held at Raritan Valley Community College. CHUBB, our Public Entity carrier, familiar with the coverages provided to the Fund, as well as an experienced litigator from Littler Mendelson will speak. Topics will include but not be limited to hiring & discharging, drafting & updating personnel & employment policies, wrongful termination, harassment, discrimination, whistleblowing, retaliation, breach of contract, FLMA, and disability accommodations, along with other areas of focus. Supervisors, Managers, Department Heads and Law Enforcement are encouraged to attend this valuable training.

Fund Attorney/Litigation Services: No additions to the report submitted.

Fund Attorney/Administrative Services: In addition to the report submitted, Fund Attorney Berry reviewed recent NJ Supreme Court LAD decision. Discussion followed. There was also a conversation involving the return of surplus which will be presented in September.

On July 18<sup>th</sup> WorkZone & Flagger Safety Training was held at Raritan Valley Community College with approximately 40 employees in attendance. Employment Practices Liability Training is scheduled for August 2<sup>nd</sup>, 9:00 a.m. at RVCC.

In the absence of Safety Committee meetings in July & August, a Summer Safety Package mailing was distributed to all Safety Representatives. The next scheduled meeting will be Tuesday, September 6<sup>th</sup>, 2016 at 9:30 a.m. at the Township of Green Brook.
