#### **SERVICE PROVIDER REPORTS**

**Executive Director/Administrator:** In addition to the report submitted, Ms. Maryjane Hydro informed all in attendance that the 2020 Auto ID Cards and 2020 Workers' Compensation Posting Notices have been distributed to all Fund Members.

The timeline for the SCJIF Fair and Open process for soliciting Request for Proposals for Professional Services the 2020 Fund Year was provided. The Request for Proposals were posted on November 21, 2019 in the Courier News, The Hunterdon Democrat and on the Fund's website.

Additionally, the proposed 2020 Meeting Schedule was reviewed. Any conflicts or changes should be requested as soon as possible prior to adoption at the January 2020 SCJIF Reorganization Meeting.

Historical tradition has been to hold the December SCJIF Commissioner's meeting on Wednesday, December 18<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at the Somerville B.P.O. Elks Lodge #1068.

Fund Attorney - Claims Management / Litigation: No additions to the report submitted.

Fund Attorney – Regulatory Compliance / Legislation: In addition to the report submitted, Fund Attorney Berry reminded public entities that OPRA requests regarding a criminal investigation should be responded to within twenty-four (24) hours of receipt as opposed to the usual seven (7) day window. She also provided an overview of the cases cited in her report. More specifically she commented on three recent cases where the Court upheld the Title 59 immunity with respect to public entities and the duty to act in terms of actual or constructive notice. Discussion followed.

#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

Safety Committee: Maryjane Hydro, NJRM, advised that the SCJIF Safety Committee met on October 1<sup>st</sup> and November 4<sup>th</sup>, 2019 and the Minutes for these Meetings are included in the report submitted. Further, that the 2019 Safety Incentive Program will be concluding on December 31st, and requested that all qualifying submissions be forwarded to T&M Associates or New Jersey Risk Managers. She reiterated that the Fund provides the necessary tools and materials to assist Member Entities in achieving compliance to ultimately receive monetary awards at the Recognition Breakfast.

Ms. Hydro also announced that since May of 2019 when the new enhancement of "On-Line Safety Training" was launched, approximately 1,140 courses have been completed thus far. Based on these results, this new safety tool is proving to be very successful. Members can access the program through the SCJIF website.

A Safety Training Seminar entitled "SCJIF Safety Manual Chapter Review" was presented by Mark Worthington of T&M Associates on Tuesday, November 26<sup>th</sup> at the Somerset County Park Commission to review the recent updates and revisions to the SCJIF Safety Manual. Approximately 25 employees were in attendance.

Per the request of the Fund Members, the 2020 Safety & Wellness Calendars were distributed in bulk during the November 4<sup>th</sup>, 2019 Safety Meeting.

The next regular SCJIF Safety Committee Meeting is scheduled for 9:00 A.M., Tuesday, December 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2019 at the Somerset County Vocational & Technical Schools TradeWins Restaurant.

He indicated that the insurance industry has been facing some challenges during recent years and we are entering a "Hard Market" where insurance carriers tend to increase their rates and premiums. Accordingly, the Preliminary Budget shows an increase of 2.655%. He assured the Fund Member that negotiations with the insurance carriers are ongoing and remains hopeful that this figure will improve as it has occurred in previous years. He thanked Lucy Martins of NJRM for assisting in the preparations of the Preliminary Budget. He welcomed questions and comments from the Fund Members.
