**Executive Director/Administrator:** No additions to the report submitted, however, Maryjane Hydro welcomed any questions and/or comments.

Fund Attorney - Claims Management / Litigation: No additions to the report submitted.

Fund Attorney – Regulatory Compliance / Legislation: In addition to the report submitted, Fund Attorney Berry provided additional comments and information regarding Bills currently pending before the Legislature which could potentially impact local law enforcement agencies and possible amendments to the "Law Against Discrimination". She is confident that these Bills, as well as others discussed in further detail in her Report, will inevitably be signed into Law.

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**Third Party Administrator:** No additions to the report submitted, however, Javier Esparra, NJRM, welcomed questions from the Fund Members.

**Custodian of Funds:** No additions to the report submitted.

#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

**Safety Committee:** In addition to the report submitted, Maryjane Hydro advised that the SCJIF Safety Committed met telephonically on June 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2020 and approximately 20 participants were on the telephone conference. The meeting was mainly focused on COVID-19 as well as guidance for returning to work safely during this pandemic. The Summer Safety Package was distributed to all Safety Committee Members on July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020 and a copy is also included in the Commissioners Package containing the following articles:

The SCJIF Safety Committee will reconvene again on Tuesday, September 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at the Annual Safety Recognition Breakfast at the Somerville B.P.O.Elks Lodge #1068. Special Guest Speaker, Laurie R. Doran, Director of Intelligence and Operations of the New Jersey Office of Homeland Security and Preparedness will provide a presentation during this event. Whether this event will be held indoors or outdoors will depend on the current situation of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Claim PAR Committee: Maryjane Hydro, NJRM, stated that the Committee met on June 24<sup>th</sup> and July 13<sup>th</sup>, 2020 and the Meeting Minutes are submitted in the Meeting Package. Actions will be ratified during the Old Business portion of the agenda.

Claim Audit Committee: Committee Chairman Brian Auger informed that a report and summary of the June 29<sup>th</sup>, 2020 meeting is included in the Meeting Package.

To further elaborate on the findings, Mr. Normand Vermette of Alan Gray, LLC addressed the Fund Members. This year the audit was conducted during the week of June 12<sup>th</sup>, 2020 via remote access. He noted that while this is the first year that the SCJIF has utilized the services of Guardian Public Entity Claims Services (GPECS) and First MCO, he was extremely pleased with the results. He explained that random samples of the five lines of coverage were taken and particular attention was placed on how well communication, claims systems, and claim handling were being managed. Mr. Vermette informed that the claims are consistently handled in accordance with the Industry's Best Practices by the new vendors. Throughout the claims handling process GPECS and FMCO are protecting the interests of the SCJIF Members. The Workers' Compensation claims reviewed, revealed that proper protocols are in place so that the injured employee can return to work as soon as possible.

Fund Attorney Berry explained that this independent audit is unique to the Somerset County Joint Insurance Fund and not done by other Joint Insurance Funds. New Jersey Risk Managers independently arranges to have

this annual claim audit completed to ascertain industry best practices of claims handling and to determine if any modifications need to be made to improve the quality of service to Somerset County Joint Insurance Fund Members.
