#### SERVICE PROVIDER REPORTS

Executive Director/Administrator: No additions to the report submitted, however, Raymond L. Hughes II welcomed any questions or comments.

Fund Attorney - Claims Management / Litigation: No additions to the report submitted.

Fund Attorney - Regulatory Compliance / Legislation: In addition to the report submitted, Fund Attorney Berry advised that the rulings in each of the cases referenced in her report will have a direct impact on public entities in the State of New Jersey and ultimately the Fund. In light of this, she provided a brief overview of the circumstances surrounding each case.

Attorney Berry also advised that new Legislation, which if signed into Law, would require both public and private employers to provide hiring preferences to injured employees who have reached Maximum Medical Improvement and cannot return to their former position but are able to perform the duties of an existing, unfilled position. Additionally, details regarding the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 which provides funding for COVID-19 response and recovery were also discussed.

**Third Party Administrator:** In addition to the report submitted, Mr. Javier Esparra welcomed questions from the Fund Members.

Custodian of Funds: No additions to the report submitted. However, Ms. Childress welcomed questions.

#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

**Safety Committee:** Ms. Maryjane Hydro, NJRM, advised that the Safety Committee met telephonically on June 8<sup>th</sup>, 2021 and the Minutes were included in the Package. Also, included was the entire Summer Safety Package which focused on FEMA's Emergency Preparations. It was comprised of the following articles:

- Make a Plan
- Create Your Family Emergency Communication Plan
- Emergency Supply List
- Prepare Your Pets for Disasters
- Plan to Evacuate
- Get Involved

The package also included the quarterly JIFNEWS which featured an article on the once every 17 years emergence of the BroodX cicadas and a piece featuring 13 home remedies for mosquito bites.

The Fund's Safety Consultant, Mark Worthington of T & M Associates conducted a safety training seminar entitled "Tractor, Mower, Groundskeeping, Hand & Portable Power Tool Safety" on July 13, 2021. Approximately 60 employees attended this in-person training seminar.

Furthermore, Ms. Hydro announced that "Chainsaw Safety Training" is scheduled for September 21, 2021 to be held at the Somerset County North Garage/Camp Cromwell in Bridgewater. This training seminar will be presented by Mr. Warren Hippeli from NJ Crane Experts of Flemington. A safety grant has been secured and additional classes will be held at the Township of Raritan October 7 and the Somerset County Park Commission October 26.

The next scheduled Safety Committee Meeting after the summer hiatus will be Tuesday, September 14 at 9:00 a.m. at the Somerset County Park Commission Second Floor Training Room.
