SERVICE PROVIDER REPORTS

Executive Director/Administrator: In addition to the Report submitted, Mr. Raymond L. Hughes welcomed questions or comments from those in attendance. Ms. Maryjane Hydro thanked all of the 2021 signatories: Commissioners Chairman-John Trojan, Secretary- Brian Auger, and Alt. Commissioner/Custodian of Funds-Yvonne Childress. With the ongoing pandemic and the hybrid working conditions each of these Commissioners diligently worked to keep the Fund operating properly and efficiently as well all of the individual Committee Members.

In light of the ongoing health crisis, Fund Members received two proposed 2022 Meeting Schedules. Historically when the Fund does not meet in person, the Claims PAR Committee meets telephonically to conduct business. All Commissioners were asked to select between the two options: either seven (7) meetings or five (5) meetings.

The Fund's Re-organization Meeting is scheduled for January 26th, 2022 and Fund Members were asked to advise whether they would prefer an "in-person" meeting or Zoom Video Conference.

Additionally, Assessment Vouchers were mailed to the Member Entities in accordance with the Fund Year 2022 Operating Budget and assessment payments are due in January 2022.

Dividend checks were distributed to all Fund Members and Mr. Raymond L. Hughes congratulated and thanked all Members for their efforts and commitment to the Somerset County Joint Insurance Fund philosophy which has made possible the ability to offer a Return of Surplus. He added that no other Joint Insurance Fund in the State of New Jersey offers return of surplus to its members. Since 2000 the Somerset County Joint Insurance Fund has been in a position to extend dividends to the Members and what makes the surplus available for return is largely the Member's commitment to safety and bringing that safety culture back to their individual entities.

Fund Attorney - Claims Management / Litigation: No additions to the report submitted.

Fund Attorney – Regulatory Compliance / Legislation: Fund Attorney Berry provided an update of the Bills that are currently being reviewed by the Legislation regarding a Workers' Compensation Act. She also expanded on Daniel's Law which prohibits disclosure of homes addresses and contact information for judicial officers and prosecutors. She welcomed questions.

Third Party Administrator: No additions to the report submitted, however, Mr. Javier Esparra welcomed questions from participants.

Custodian of Funds: No additions to the report submitted.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Safety Committee: On behalf of Committee Chairperson Sipple, Ms. Maryjane Hydro, NJRM, advised that the Safety Committee met on December 7th, 2021 and the Meeting Minutes were distributed electronically. New Jersey Risk Managers has also distributed information on Winter Storm Precautions to assist our Fund Members with preparations for emergencies during the winter months. All in attendance were reminded that New Jersey Risk Managers is available 24/7 to assist entities during emergencies. Should the need arise to report a claim after working hours, individuals are able to contact the answering service and a member of the team will be in touch as soon as practical. New Jersey Risk Manager is also able to provide recommendations to preferred vendors should it be necessary.

The Safety Committee will meet in person on January 11th, 2022 at 9:00 A.M. at the Somerset County Vocational & Technical Schools TradeWins Restaurant. Committee Members who are not able to attend in person will be provided with instructions to connect to the meeting telephonically.
