Fund Attorney – Regulatory Compliance / Legislation: In addition to the report submitted, Fund Attorney Berry expanded on a case currently being heard in the Appellate Division involving the Open Records Act and provided an update on the Legislature referenced in her Report. Discussion followed.

Third Party Administrator: No additions to the report submitted, however, Mr. Javier Esparra welcomed questions from the Fund Members.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Safety Committee: In addition to the report submitted on behalf of Committee Chair Sipple, Maryjane Hydro of NJRM, advised that the SCJIF Safety Committee met in-person and via telephone on January 11th, 2022 at the Somerset County Vocational & Technical Schools / TradeWins Restaurant. Ms. Hydro added that meeting inperson not only provides an opportunity to interact with the students involved in the Culinary Arts Program but Safety Committee Representatives also have an opportunity to share ideas for the benefit of the safety culture environment. However, a telephonic option remains available for Safety Representatives that prefer to dial-in as opposed to meeting in person.

Safety Representatives were also advised that the 2021 Safety Incentive Program concluded December 31, 2021; however, submissions can be forwarded until January 31, 2022 to receive credit. Final results will be provided at the annual Safety Recognition Awards Breakfast. Ms. Hydro also advised that the Safety On-Line Training Program offered thru the Fund's website is currently being upgraded. A new and improved version of the On-Line Safety Training Program should be launched in the next 30 days. Finally, the SCJIF First Quarter Training Seminar entitled "Confined Space" will be held on Thursday, February 24th, 2022 via Microsoft Teams and it will be conducted by the Fund's Safety Representative Mark Worthington of T &M Associates.

The next scheduled Safety Meeting will be held at the Somerset County Vocational & Technical Schools/ Trade Wins Restaurant and telephonically on Tuesday, February 1st at 9:00 a.m.
