At this time, Ms. Maryjane Hydro, NJRM introduced Mr. Rich Malewicz the Director of Business Development at Wizer, Inc. Mr. Malewicz has an extensive professional background and is also a Commissioned Intelligence Officer (Major) for the U.S. Army Reserve's Cyber Command with over 25 years of experience in the U.S. Army, both in active and reserve capacities. Previously, he served as the Deputy County Administrator and CIO/CISO for Livingston County, Michigan. Rich's academic credentials include an MBA from the University of Michigan and a Certificate of AI from MIT. His comprehensive experience in government, cybersecurity and business development makes him an accomplished leader, capable of navigating complex challenges in a rapidly evolving landscape.

Mr. Malewicz proceeded to address the Board and provided an overview of the cyber security training programs that have been accessible free of charge to all Fund Members since 2022. He stressed the importance of taking advantage of these valuable training tools as cyber security breaches continue to affect municipal governmental entities on a regular basis and many of these incidents can be avoided by proper training. Cyber Security Awareness Program Best Practices were provided in the Commissioners' folders. Questions were welcomed.

Ms. Hydro added that some Fund Members have been working with Wizer to participate in these free training programs. Shortly, NJRM will be scheduling a Zoom Training Seminar for Administrators and all Information System and Computer Technician employees to expand on how to have greater Cyber strengthening of their individual Fund Member programs. Additional information regarding the Zoom training will be forthcoming.

For the fourth quarter of 2023, NJRM has made participation in this upcoming Zoom training a compliance component of the SCJIF Safety Incentive Program. However, in January 2024, NJRM will be introducing the new SCJIF Cyber Incentive Program. Like the Safety Incentive Program, Cyber Incentive will track monthly training participation with Wizer and afford the opportunity for cash incentive rewards.
